## Concert Attire (choose from the following):

Long black dress or black robe (below the knees when seated) with black socks/hosiery and black dress shoes. Dress must cover the shoulders.

Black, long-sleeve, button-down shirt/blouse and black skirt/dress pants with black socks/hosiery and black dress shoes; Black sport coat/tuxedo jacket optional.

### **Student Notes:**

- Bring your concert attire on a hanger; because you'll eat two meals that day, we encourage you NOT to wear your concert attire all day.
- Students can wear any dress-code appropriate clothing during the day.
- Each student will need to bring two mechanical pencils, your music and a water bottle.

### Learning the Music:

Drs. Kellussell will have your music in late November and we will schedule time to help you learn it before you go. You are responsible for learning most of it on your own – visit www.MTVA.org for learning files (part-learning files will be ready in late November as well).

## Transportation After the Concert

• Students MUST ride home with a parent that evening. Send Dr. Kelly/Dr. Russell a Remind text when you leave so we have a record of when everyone leaves.

#### Parent Notes:

- Please use Remind to contact Dr. Kelly/Dr. Russell during the day in case of emergency and you cannot get in touch with your child (phones aren't allowed in rehearsal).
- There should be plenty of parking at Belle Aire Baptist. However, seating capacity will be an issue. We would strongly advise, if at all possible, to arrive by 5:30 and find a seat, even if that means taking off from work and eating dinner early.
